Construction starts on new \$32M Warrigal Queanbeyan Development

- The first development of its kind in Queanbeyan
- Major boost for the local economy
- Set to open late 2019

Warrigal is thrilled to announce major construction of its new state-of-the-art Residential Care Home, complete with 125 suites, will commence next month.

This is great news following the demolition of the old redundant building to make way for the new development which has been described by some as a modern day "cruise ship" on land.

The new development will not only double the number of residential care beds available onsite to help cater for the demand in the local community, but will offer a completely new type of retirement living never before seen in the region.

CEO of Warrigal, Mark Sewell, said it's an exciting new era for Warrigal and signifies great confidence in the Queanbeyan area.

"This development will also create numerous jobs during construction including additional ripple effects with those on-site expected to use local businesses to buy their coffees, snacks, lunches a building materials.
