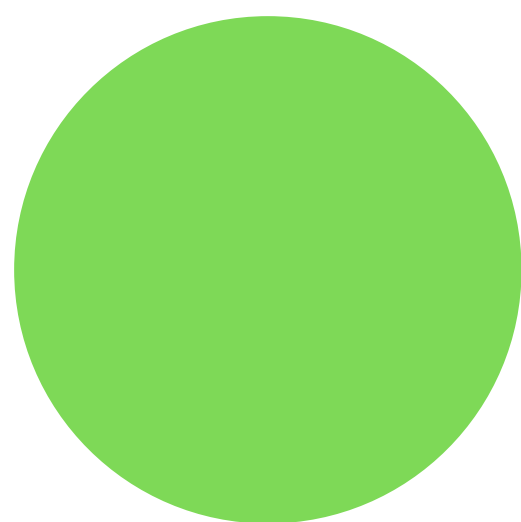
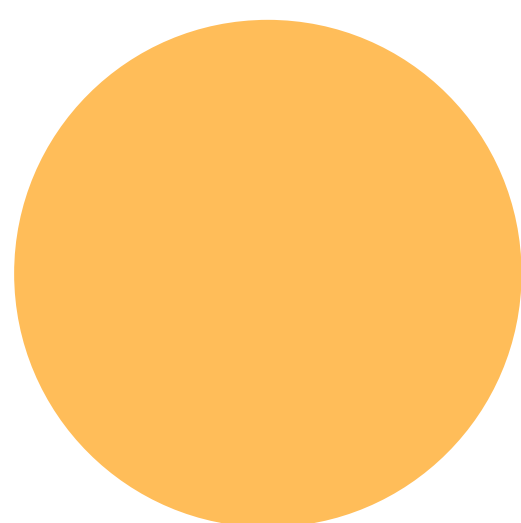


Warrigal's COVID-19 Traffic Light System for Visitors

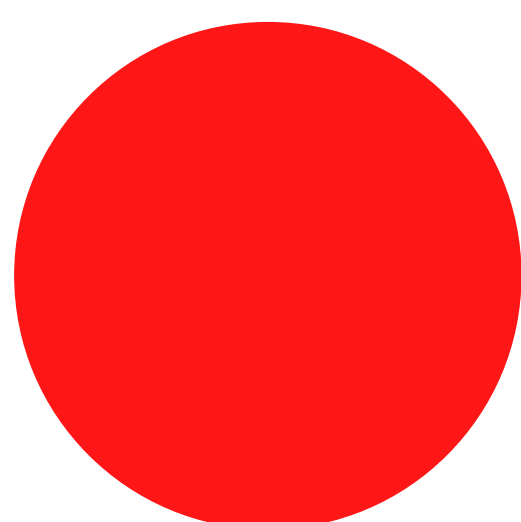
To effectively communicate any visiting restrictions that may affect a care home, we have developed a traffic light system based on different scenarios of confirmed COVID-19 cases. Please see our guide below, and email warrigal@warrigal.com.au if you have any questions about this.



Fully vaccinated visitors have no restrictions on visiting with PPE required in accordance with Public Health Orders. Unvaccinated visitors would be required to have a Rapid Antigen Test or evidence of a recent PCR test with bookings required and visits outdoors.



There has been a positive case as a venue in close proximity to the care home. Only those fully vaccinated can visit unless it's for an end of life visit and bookings would be required. Rapid Antigen Tests may also be required depending on the location of the venue and the number of cases.



There has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the home. One person who is the "Essential Visitor" would be permitted to visit with a Rapid Antigen Test required.
